Linz – a cultural metropolis, and an oasis of green. Linz an der Donau is an innovative, contemporary city. It is a place where nature, culture and business come together to form a harmonious whole. The 2009 European Capital of Culture sports the slogan “Linz, verändert” (“Linz, changes”), and lives up to the slogan in full. Linz, a successful location for business, has emerged as an outstanding destination for culture, offering dynamism and a high quality of life. The capital city of Upper Austria is a showcase for theatre and music, but equally for contemporary art, history and science.

THE CITY



“Linz, verändert” – “Linz, changes”

The city lives by its slogan: Linz is the place where historical stucco façades from earlier eras line up stylishly alongside architecturally significant, futuristically-lit buildings. The large number of new buildings that have been constructed offer a broad spectrum of modern highlights in urban design. The Ars Electronica Center – the Museum of the Future – graces the left bank of the Danube, as an LED-illuminated celebration in glass.

The new southern wing of the Linzer Schloss castle affords stunning views over the city, and is home to Austria’s biggest universal museum. In the world of steel that is the visitor and exhibition centre of voestalpine AG, visitors can experience the processing stages involved in manufacturing steel at first-hand.

But Linz offers much more: the city presents itself as modern and cosmopolitan, offering a winning combination of diversity, design and creativity.

The ‘city on the Danube’ is also a magnet for art and culture. Throughout the year, Linz is a platform for music, theatre, film, history and art – from the ancient classics to media art. At Easter, Passion concerts are performed in the various churches around Linz. Anyone keen on playing or watching sport will enjoy the OMV Linz Donau Marathon and the Trirun Linz Triathlon. Every summer, the contemporary setting of the Rosengarten am Pöstlingberg becomes a venue for open-air concerts, cabaret performances and theatre. During Advent, Linz transforms into a glittering Yuletide city, sporting the slogan of "Stille, Stahl und Sterne" ("Silent Night, steel and stars").

Alongside the fixed points on the Linz cultural calendar such as the Crossing Europe Festival and the Biennale Cuvée in Spring, the Whitsun LinzFest, the Pflasterspektakel (an international street art festival) in July, the Ars Electronica Festival, the Brucknerfest and the Linzer Klangwolken in September (and many more), Linz is also home to a large number of other events.

The gastronomic scene in Linz makes it easy to enjoy Linz as a treat for all the senses. Upper Austrian cuisine is based on a wealth of traditions and customs. Typical Upper Austrian delicacies such as Schweinsbraten mit Knödel (roast pork with dumplings) and Sauerkraut (pickled cabbage) are two of the local favourites. When it comes to beer, in Upper Austria it is more than just something to quench a thirst it is a longstanding part of the culture, firmly rooted in the traditions of the area. Across the whole region, you will find many breweries with their own unique speciality beers, with something to suit every taste. Most – a fermented apple or pear juice - is considered the national drink of Upper Austria. From mild to muscular, from sweet to crisp, Most is to be found in every conceivable taste option.

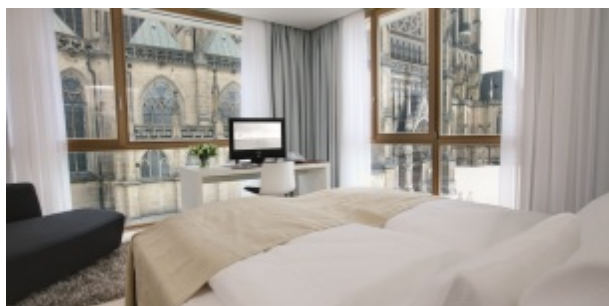

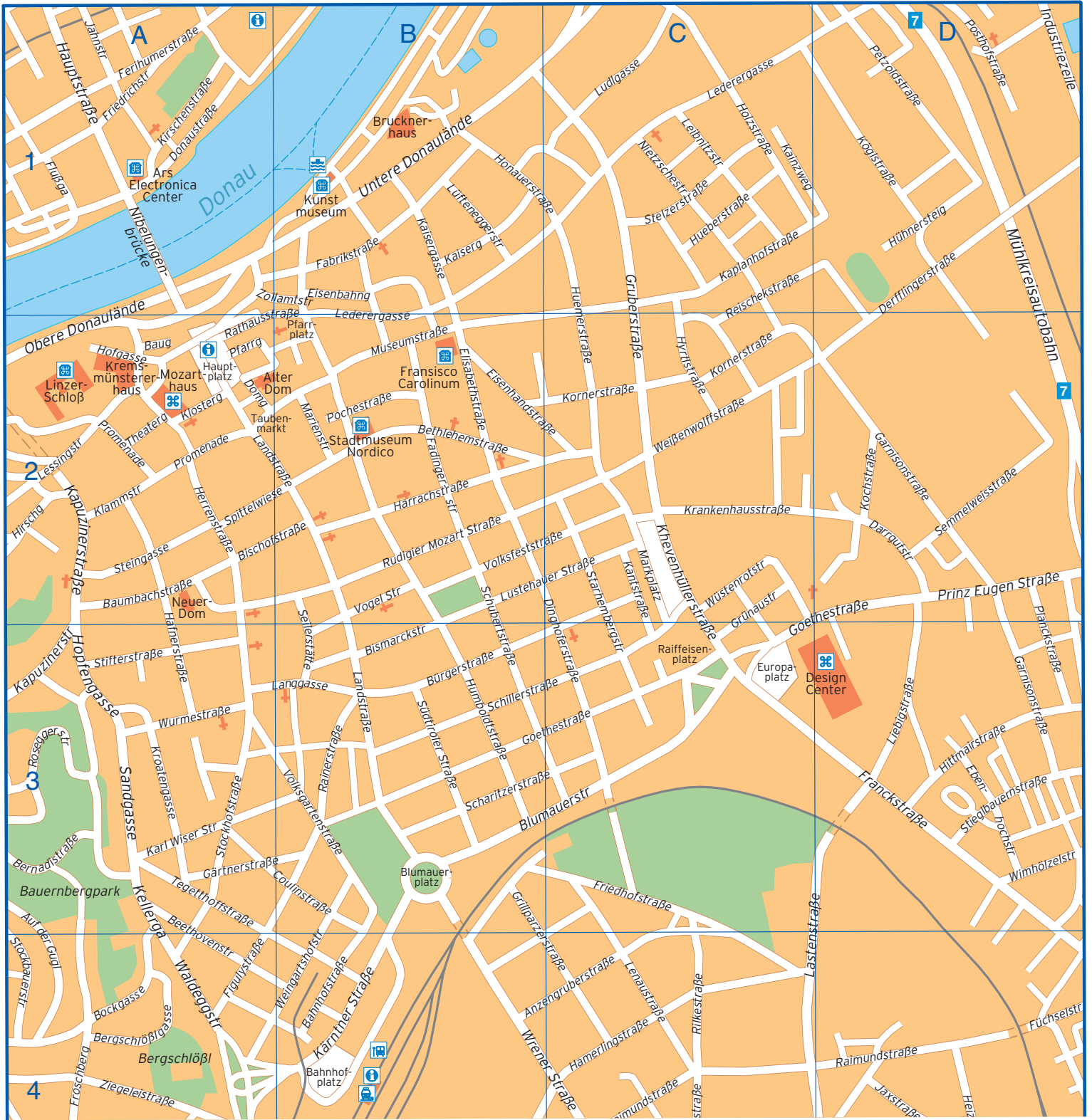
