## THE TOWN

Dennis Port, a charming village nestled on the north side of Nantucket Sound, offers a quintessential Cape Cod experience. Just an hour and a half from Boston and a short ferry ride from Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket, this idyllic retreat within the town of Dennis beckons with its rich history, pristine beaches, and relaxed coastal ambiance.

Dennis, considered part of the "Mid Cape" region along with Barnstable — the Cape's largest town and namesake of Barnstable County — boasts 18 beaches renowned as some of the finest in the United States. These sandy shores, caressed by the gentle waves of Nantucket Sound, provide endless opportunities for sunbathing, swimming, and beachcombing.

Established as a separate entity in 1793, Dennis has deep roots in seafaring tradition. The historic Shiverick Shipyard, once a booming hub of shipbuilding activity, is commemorated by a plaque, a reminder of the town's maritime heritage. This legacy continues today, as the waters teem with fishing boats and private vessels, adding a picturesque touch to the coastal scenery.

Dennis Port's streets are lined with stately mansions, many of which were once the

residences of sea captains. These grand homes, with their elegant architecture and historical significance, add a touch of grandeur to the village's landscape. Some of these mansions have been lovingly preserved as private residences, while others have been transformed into atmospheric bed and breakfasts, offering a delightful lodging option for history enthusiasts.

Beyond its historical allure, Dennis Port provides modern amenities and a vibrant beachtown atmosphere. Explore a variety of shops and boutiques, savor delicious seafood at local restaurants, or simply relax and soak up the Cape Cod charm. With its blend of history, natural beauty, and modern comforts, Dennis Port has become a beloved vacation spot, attracting generations of travelers seeking a quintessential Cape Cod experience.

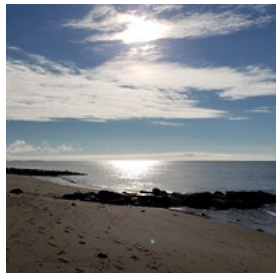

### Sea Street Beach

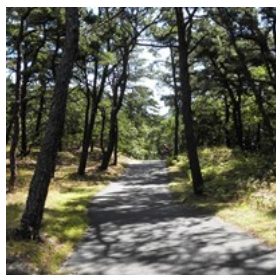

### Jericho Historical Center



Located in the old town of West Dennis, Jericho Historical Center features historical buildings that served as home to the town's early residents.

Captain Theophilus Baker's house, built in 1801 and occupied by the Baker family in 1855, exhibits original furnishings, textiles, paintings and keepsakes, while Barn Museum offers insight into typical 19th century farm ambiance. Don't miss the cranberry exhibit, which delves into the 200-year-old story of this industry and the important role it played for Dennis since 1816.

### 1736 Josiah Dennis Manse Museum



The Josiah Dennis Manse, built in 1736, stands as one of the oldest buildings in Massachusetts. Once home to the town's

namesake, Reverend Josiah Dennis, the manse now serves as a museum showcasing artifacts from his life and the early days of Dennis. Explore exhibits dedicated to his children's room, spinning and weaving techniques, and other aspects of 18th-century life. The complex also includes the 1745 schoolhouse, offering a glimpse into the history of education in the region.

### West Dennis Light



Previously known as Bass River Lighthouse, the tower was built in 1853 atop a large keeper's house and represents one of the first examples of

"Cape Cod style" lighthouses. With its range of 12 miles and a white light flash every 6 seconds, it has been operating constantly for almost half a century since it was constructed. Now is the venue of a seasonal hotel called At the Lighthouse Inn.

### Best Time to Visit



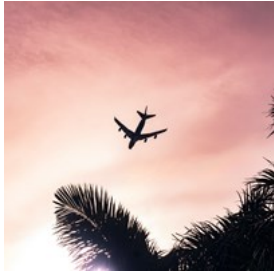
Dennis Port, located on Cape Cod, experiences a humid climate with frequent windy days due to its proximity to the Atlantic Ocean. Summer attracts the most tourists, drawn by warm temperatures and minimal precipitation, ideal for beach activities. However, late spring or early autumn offer a less crowded experience and potentially lower accommodation prices.

For those seeking autumnal beauty, the second week of October provides vibrant foliage displays. November, with an average high of 51°F, still offers pleasant weather for exploring Cape Cod's sights and sounds.

The shoulder months — May, June, September, and October — offer a balance of pleasant weather, manageable crowds, and reasonable room rates.

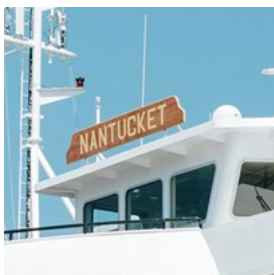

### Passport/Visa



Citizens of the Schengen countries, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Japan, South Korea,

Taiwan and the Kingdom of Brunei can visit the United States for up to 90 days without applying for a visa (as well as citizens of Andorra, Lichtenstein, Monaco and San Marino). Citizens of these countries must obtain an ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) before traveling. All other travelers must obtain a visa before visiting the United States. International travelers need a passport that is valid for at least 3 months after the end of their intended trip in order to enter the country.

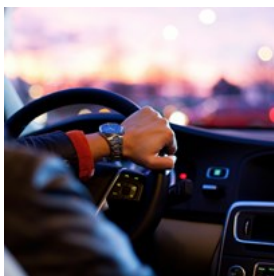

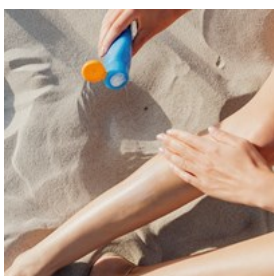

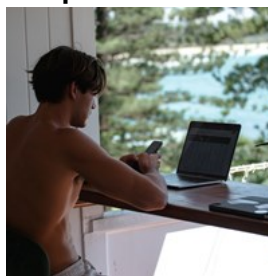
