Örebro is an attractive city boasting well-preserved historic areas along the river Svartån. While the grand Vasa Castle gathers the majority of the attention for its historical significance, Örebro offers a dynamic mix of old-world charm and modern vibrancy. The city's architectural diversity, coupled with an array of entertainment venues, shops, and cafés, creates a lively urban atmosphere. Within a short distance from the city, natural wonders such as Lake Hjälmarén and Kilsbergen, "The Blue Mountains," provide great outdoor experiences.

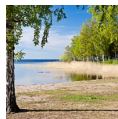

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## THE CITY

Örebro's picturesque town centre stands as a testament to its rich cultural heritage, harking back to the medieval era when the bustling trade routes intersected at the crossing of the Svartå River. The town flourished around the 13th century with the construction of the "Örebron" bridge over Svartån, evolving into a thriving commercial hub.

Thanks to its central location in the middle of Svealand, Örebro has often been an eye-catcher throughout the years. Count Karl, the son of Gustav Vasa, left an indelible mark by transforming the medieval castle into the grand Vasa Castle in the late 17th century.

The meandering river Svartån weaves through Örebro, leaving its distinct mark on the cityscape. A stroll along the nature path unveils scenic waterfalls, and a visit to the Wadköping open-air museum offers a glimpse into the city's past with its charming arts and crafts booths and shops. Örebro invites exploration along the riverbanks, where the fusion of nature and history creates an enchanting experience.

### Örebro Castle



In the heart of the city stands the stately Örebro castle, the gathering point in the city for more than 700 years. Once a simple castle for defence and prison, it was rebuilt as a royal castle during the Vasa era. Today, the castle is an open tourist attraction, with tours, exhibitions, a restaurant and a café, as well as the Örebro Läns Museum.

### Lillån Path



In the northern part of the city winds Lilla Å-promenaden offering a place to stroll and ride your bicycle. It is approximately four

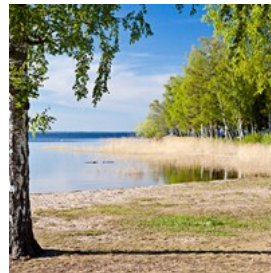
The cultural reserve of Karlslund is a scenic area with a long history and is only five kilometres from Örebro's city centre. In this idyll, you'll find

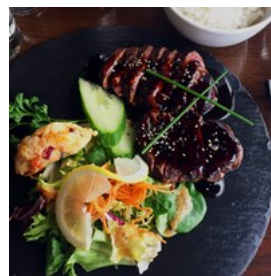

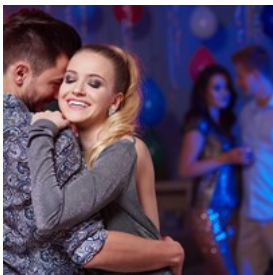

If you are unsure whether or not you need to apply for a visa, we recommend contacting the embassy or consulate in your country.

International (non-Schengen) travellers need a passport that is valid for at least 3 months after the end of their intended trip in order to enter the Schengen zone. Citizens of Schengen countries can travel without a passport but must have a valid ID with them during their stay.

### Örebro Airport (ORB)



Örebro Airport, from where charter, national, and freight flights operate, is situated 12 km west of Örebro. The journey to the city centre of Örebro by taxi takes approx. 15 minutes. Let's Go By Bus AB operates the route between Örebro Airport and Örebro Travel Centre. Tickets can be purchased at Flixbus's website or onboard via card payment. In addition, several car rental companies are represented at this airport.

### Public Transport



The city centre of Örebro can easily be explored on foot. However, there is a well-functioned network of city buses managed by Länstrafiken. City buses depart from Järntorget in central Örebro and from Resecentrum (Travel Center) at Centralstationen.

You can pay for your journey by using Länstrafiken Resekort (Travel Card), a debit/credit card, or via their app on your smartphone. You can get your travel card and charge it at the customer centre at Örebro's Resecentrum, from other sales agents like kiosks (Pressbyrån) and supermarkets or on board one of the buses. Notice that you cannot use cash on the bus.

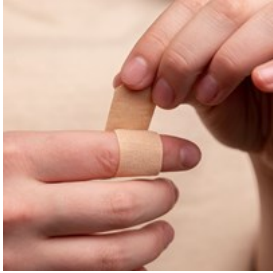

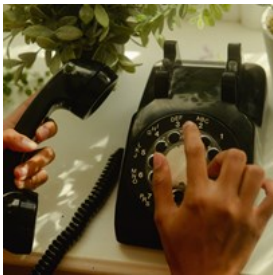

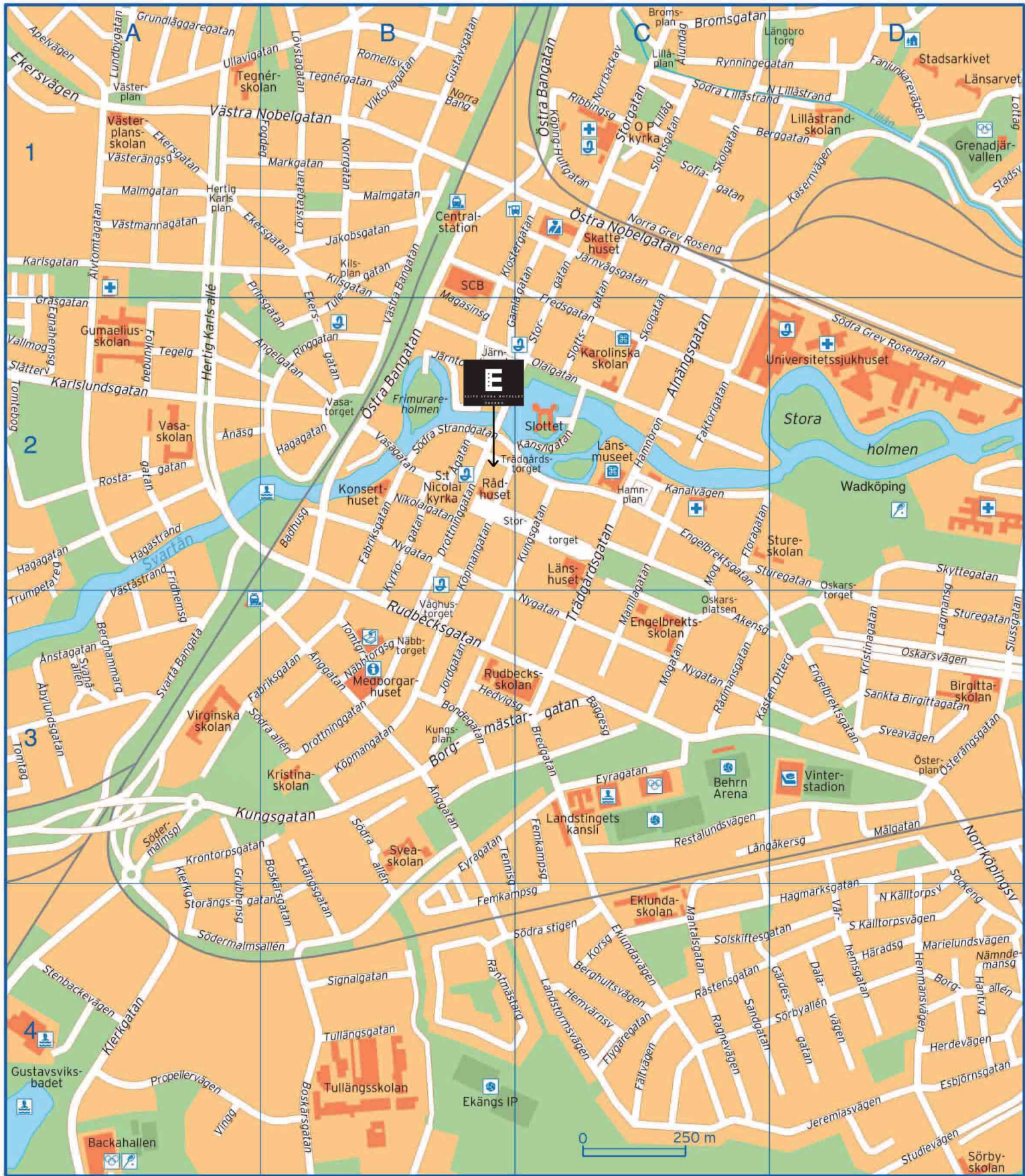
