If you want to understand something about Umeå before visiting the city, you can ponder these figures. 75,000 people live in the densely built-up areas. Of these 35,000 are students at the university — that's over 40 percent. Umeå is one of Sweden's most important student towns and it influences everything from culture, sport and entertainment to intellectual stimulation.

Festivals, lectures, and concerts are almost daily events in Umeå. The challenge often lies in choosing from the myriad of options rather than finding them. The music scene varies widely, encompassing everything from folk and jazz evenings to major rock concerts, with the jazz festival being one of the oldest in Europe. Umeå Open is the country's largest indoor festival with pop, rock and club music, while the Norrland Opera, which works with the Umeå Symphony Orchestra, satisfies the need for classical music. This vibrant cultural scene, alongside cutting-edge companies in biomedical and IT industries, imbues the City of Birches with a palpable sense of innovation, optimism and confidence.

While a significant portion of Sweden's electricity is generated from Västerbotten's rivers, these waterways offer tourists different attractions. The Vindel River, one of the

country's largest undeveloped rivers, is just one example of the waters providing opportunities for fishing and paddling. At the same time, the surrounding wilderness is perfect for adventures like beaver safaris and white-water rafting.

Västerbottens Museum



The permanent exhibitions at the Västerbotten Museum delve into the county's ancient history, cultural heritage, settler life and

reindeer husbandry. It also houses a remarkable photographic collection of Sune Jonsson, capturing the essence of the Norrland agricultural landscape.

In the summer, the outdoor museum at Gammlia buzzes with activity. Historical buildings, relocated from various parts of the county, together with period-costumed cottage hosts and farm animals, create an authentic atmosphere.

Three different Sami settlements have been recreated at Gammlia. In the winter, visitors can explore the permanent exhibitions and wander through the grounds.

Umedalens Sculpture Park



Skulpturparken, which is located in the former hospital compound in Umedalen, is considered to be one of Europe's most distinguished

sculpture parks and is also one of Västerbottens most visited sites in the summer. More than 150 Swedish and international artists have since the start in 1994 exhibited their works in Umedalen Skulptur, an exhibition that is organized every summer. Today there are also 26 permanent works in the park.

Skulpturparken also has a garden landscape in connection with the IKSU Spa, Umeå's so-called cultural spa. The garden is created by one of Sweden's famous landscaping artists, Ulf Nordfjell.

Sweden can be visited visa-free for up to 90 days by citizens of Australia, New Zealand, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Malaysia, Israel, UAE and most countries in America. If you are unsure whether or not you need to apply for a visa, we recommend contacting the embassy or consulate in your country. International (non-Schengen)

travellers need a passport that is valid for at least 3 months after the end of their intended trip in order to enter the Schengen zone. Citizens of Schengen countries can travel without a passport but must have a valid ID with them during their stay.

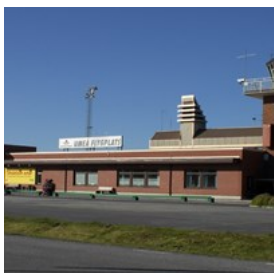
Best Time to Visit

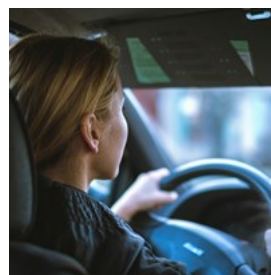
Public Transport
