### Passport/Visa



Citizens of Schengen Area countries, along with Andorra, Australia, Brunei, Canada, Ireland, Japan, Monaco, New Zealand, San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, and the United Kingdom, can visit the United States for up to 90 days without needing a visa, provided they obtain an approved ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) before their trip. All other travelers must secure a visa before visiting the U.S.

In addition, international travelers must ensure their passport is valid for at least six months beyond their intended stay. For the most current information and any updates on entry requirements, it is advisable to consult the U.S. Department of State website or contact the nearest U.S. embassy or consulate before

traveling.

### **Palm Beach International Airport (PBI)**



Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) is located just 8 kilometers from downtown West Palm Beach, making it a convenient arrival point

for travelers. The airport is easily accessible via taxis, rideshare services like Uber and Lyft, and public transportation. Taxis and rideshares are available at the airport's Ground Transportation area, and Palm Tran buses provide routes to the city center, with Route 44 being a popular option. For those looking for more personalized transport, shuttle services like SuperShuttle and Prime Time Shuttle are also available.

For those preferring to rent a car, PBI hosts several car rental agencies in the Rental Car Center, just a short shuttle ride from the terminal. Travel time to downtown West Palm Beach typically takes between 10 and 20 minutes, depending on traffic.

### **Best time to Visit**



West Palm Beach can be enjoyed year-round thanks to its subtropical climate. However, to avoid the hottest temperatures and largest crowds, the best times to visit are late spring (April to May) and early fall (September to

October). Keep in mind that fall also marks Florida's hurricane season, so while weather disruptions are possible, severe hurricanes rarely impact the region. Summer brings high temperatures and humidity, though hotel rates tend to be lower during this period. On the other hand, from December to February, the weather is cooler and more pleasant, but it's also the peak season, which makes the city more expensive to visit.

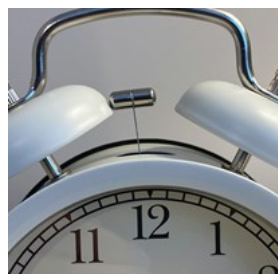


Post offices in West Palm Beach typically operate from Monday to Friday, with opening hours from 9am to 5pm. Some locations may have
