
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


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THE CITY

Dennis Port is located an hour and a half from the Massachusetts capital of Boston and is centrally-located in Cape Cod. This little village within the town of Dennis lies along Nantucket Sound, a short ferry ride from the islands of Martha's Vineyards and Nantucket. The town of Dennis is considered part of the "Mid Cape" region along with Barnstable, the Cape's largest town that also gives the name to the county where Cape Cod is located. In itself, Dennis is home to 18 beaches, which are known as some of the best in the USA.

The town was first founded in 1639 as part of the town of Yarmouth, until It separated from the latter in 1793. Historically, Dennis has been a seafaring town, with commerce centered around Shiverick Shipyard, which is now marked by a plaque at the historic site. The maritime tradition continues in the Cape, and the waters are filled with fishing and private vessels throughout the year.

Also notable in the area are the stately mansions, since many of them had been historic captains' homes. Some of these mansions are still inhabited today, while others have been remodeled and converted into bed and breakfasts-a perfect choice of lodgings for this history enthusiast. Rich in history, yet still filled with modern delights and facilities, Dennis Port is really a destination that everyone would appreciate: it is quickly apparent why tourists have flocked to the Cape for decades and made it a primary vacation spot.

Jericho Historical Center



Located in old town of West Dennis, Jericho Historical Center features historical buildings that served as home to the early inhabitants of the

town. Captain Theophilus Baker's house, built in 1801 and occupied by the Baker family in 1855, exhibits original furnishings, textiles, paintings and keepsakes, while Barn Museum offers insight into typical 19th century farm ambiance. Don't miss the cranberry exhibit, which displays the the 200-year-old story of this industry and the important role it played for Dennis since 1816.

1736 Josiah Dennis Manse Museum

Joisiah Dennis, the man whom the town was named after. Now it has been turned into a museum displaying artifacts of his early life, children's room, spinning and weaving exhibit. The complex also includes the old 1745 school house on its grounds.

Indian Lands Conservation Area



Behind town Office, A coastal area of 25 acres of woodland and marshes hides a unique environment: every year during the winter months,

the shores of Bass River are the typical destination of Nobscusset Indians, a native american community who continues to reside in this natural pearl since 1778. When winter comes, these people come along and built their wigwams along the shores of Bass River, where they use to relax until Spring arrives and brings Lady Slipper Orchid to the river's meadows.



Citizens of the Schengen countries, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, Japan, South Korea,

Taiwan and the Kingdom of Brunei can visit the United States for up to 90 days without applying for a visa (as well as citizens of Andorra, Lichtenstein, Monaco and San Marino). Citizens of these countries must obtain an ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) before traveling. All other travelers must obtain a visa before visiting the United States. International travelers need a passport that is valid for at least 3 months after the end of their intended trip in order to enter the country.
